ULFA-I [United Liberation Front of Asom-Independent]

- ▶ Strength - Approximately 150
- ▶ Largely Myanmar based
- ▶ Overground base in Assam
- ▶ Extensive usage of Social media
- ▶ Active in Upper Assam
- ▶ Carried out kidnappings in Arunachal Pradesh and Sibsagar District of Assam

Insurgency Scenario

- ▶ Assam re-declared as Disturbed Area on 22/02/2021 for 6 months
- ▶ AFSPA in force in the entire state

DNLA [Dimasa National Liberation Army]

- ▶ Strength - Approximately 12 [Of these 6 neutralized early this week]
- ▶ Active in Karbi Anglong and Dima Hasao
- ▶ Bases in Nagaland
- ▶ Active support of NSCN-IM

KLO [Kamatapur Liberation Organisation]

- ▶ Strength - Approximately 15
- ▶ Active in Lower Assam Districts [Dhubri, Kokrajhar, Bongaigaon]
- ▶ Activities and shelter in Meghalaya and North Bengal
- ▶ Are known to frequent Myanmar

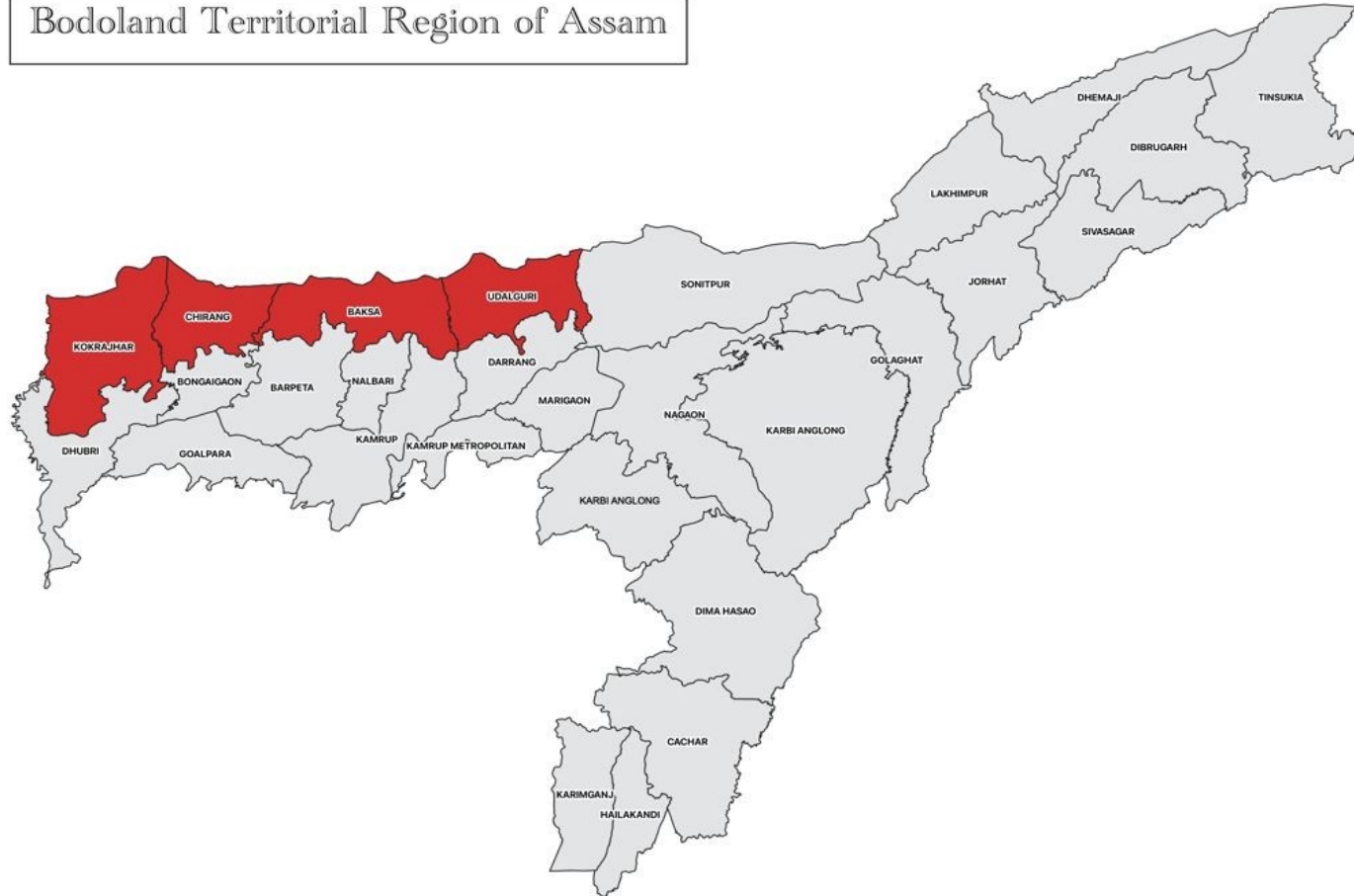

- ▶ Recently **50 children** belonging to BTR area, who were trafficked and employed in hazardous environment outside the state, have been **rescued** by Assam Police
- ▶ Steps have been taken for **rehabilitation** of rescued children

Rehabilitation of Surrendered Militants

- Under “Swabalamban Scheme” of Govt. of Assam-
 - **Approx. 1800** cadres of various outfits have been given training on skill development by SIPRD
 - Out of which **1192** already received benefits of **Rs. 1 lakhs** each for entrepreneurial development and self employment
 - Proposal to rehabilitate another **1000** Surrendered Cadres under this scheme with enhanced amount of **Rs. 2 lakh** per head is under consideration
- Under “Surrendered cum Rehabilitation Policy” of Gol-
 - **2349** SoO Cadres and **1503** Surrendered Cadres of different outfits are receiving stipend of **Rs. 6,000/-** per head per month
 - Under this scheme **1503** Surrendered Cadres of different outfits have already received one time grant of **Rs. 4 lakhs** per head

Status of implementation of Bodo Accord

- **Rehabilitation Measures-**
 - Under “Surrender Cum Rehabilitation Scheme” a total of **1279** (NDFB(P)-835; NDFB(RD)-444) cadres are receiving monthly stipend of **Rs. 6000/- each per month**
 - A total of **288 NDFB(S)** cadres have been sanctioned a stipend of **Rs. 6000/- each per month** and also a **one time grant of Rs. 4 Lakh each** . The amount sanctioned will be released shortly.
 - Fixed deposit certificates of one time grant amounting to **Rs. 4 lakh each** were distributed to total **1429** cadres of NDFB.
 - **177** nos. of NDFB(P) and **95** nos. of NDFB(RD) cadres benefitted by financial grant under “Swabalamban Scheme”
 - **1717** cadres of NDFB have been recently imparted **skill development training** by SIPRD .
- The Screening committee has **recommended 274 non-heinous cases** registered against **427 ex-militants** for withdrawal
