Topics like History of Assam: The Ahom Era and The Colonial Period, Geography of Assam: Locational and Physical Profile and Population and Socio-Economic Profile, Overview of Police Administration in Assam, Overview of Assam Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act, Administrative Structure of the Sixth Schedule Areas in Assam, Introduction of Finance Department, Assam; Food, Civil Supplies &

Consumer Affairs Department, Assam; Health & Family Welfare Department, Assam; School Education & Higher Education Departments, Assam; ARTPPG Department, Assam; Revenue & Disaster Management Department, Assam; Public Health Engineering Department, Assam; Agriculture & Horticulture Department, Assam; Skill. Employment Entrepreneurship & Department, Assam: Social Justice Empowerment Department, Assam; Panchayat & Rural Development Department, Assam and their Flagship Programmes and New Initiatives, Forest & Environment in Assam: Issues and Challenges, Industrial Development in Assam, Ease of Doing Business, Ease of Living, Smart City etc., Externally Aided Projects in Assam, Overview of the Tea Industry in Assam, Urban Bodies: Administrative Structure. # Organizational Culture and Change Management

A 2-Day Training on 'Reservation in Services' was held at AASC on 27th and 28th June, 2023, which was organized by Centre for Law, Justice & Human Rights (LJ&HR), Assam Administrative Staff College, Guwahati under sponsorship of Government of Assam.

Various sessions were undertaken by domain experts on topics namely- Reservation, SC/ST categories, The Assam SC, ST (Reservation of posts in services) act 1978, as amended in 2012,2021 and Rules thereof, The Assam district wise population pattern reflection (in services in Class III/IV posts) Act 1994, Relaxations, concessions, exemptions, ZOC, Forest dweller Act, 2006, Exercise on de reservation proposal, Hands on preparation of post based roster in department and Work-Life Balance. Fifty-Nine (59) participants from several Department/Directorates/ District of Assam had attended the training.

#### Cabinet Memorandum and e-Cabinet



A one-day workshop on 'Cabinet Memorandum and e-Cabinet' was organized by the Centre for Law, Justice & Human Rights under Assam Administrative Staff College on 30th June 2023.

35 ACS officers from 1995 to 2017 batch attended the workshop.
